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Privacy Policy

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1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy applies to the DEEVINE online interface (i.e., website or mobile application) and any DEEVINE affiliate or subsidiary online interface that links to this Policy, (individually referred to as a "site", and, collectively, "sites"). The term "the company" or "DEEVINE" or "we" or "us" or "our" in this Policy refers to the product DEEVINE; the company with proprietary ownership of the product, Legend Labs Limited; and any affiliates or subsidiaries of Legend Labs Limited that link to this Policy. This Policy describes how the Sites may collect, use, and share information from or about you, and explains how information may be collected and used for advertising purposes.

DEEVINE takes the privacy of your information very seriously. Please read this Policy carefully. By using the Site and any services we offer via the Site, you are agreeing to be bound by this Policy in respect of the information collected about you via this Site.

As a Customer, you accept this Policy when you sign up for, access, or use our product(s), services, content, features, technologies or functions offered on our website and all related sites, applications, and services.

This Policy is intended to govern the use of the Site by users. Users reserve the right to exercise their data protection rights as listed under the Customer Rights.

This Policy regulates how personal information will be used within the Company. To preserve the confidentiality of your data, we maintain the controls in place for privacy.

2. Collection of Information

We will collect the following information from you:

- i. Name, username, gender, date of birth/age;
- ii. Email address, postal address, telephone number;
- iii. Your interests;
- iv. Credit card number and expiry date;
- v. Dependents.

Although it is not compulsory to give us this information, if you do not then we may not be able to provide you with the full range of services that the Site has to offer. Information is collected electronically and manually when you visit our website and register to use any of our services.

Information is collected electronically with exchanges between your system or service provider's system and our system.

We collect your information manually when you complete our product and services registration forms in registering to use any of our services. Similar information is also collected when customers or visitors visit our physical locations for inquiries or business relationship.

3. Use of this Information

We will use this information to:

- i. Administer your accounts with us;
- ii. Process requests submitted by you;
- iii. Send you information about the community or church you sign up for;
- iv. Carry out community analysis and make general improvements or arrangements for your use of our Site;
- v. Carry out marketing analysis and make general improvements to our Site;
- vi. Obtain your views or comments on the services we provide;
- vii. Respond to your inquiries and fulfil your requests;
- viii. Inform you about important information regarding your community, our Site, products or services for which you apply or may be interested in applying for, or in which you are already enrolled, changes to terms, conditions, and policies and/or other administrative information;
- ix. Deliver marketing communications that we believe may be of interest to you, including, ads or offers tailored to you;
- x. Allow you to apply for products or services;
- xi. Verify your identity and/or location, to allow access to your accounts and to maintain measures aimed at preventing illegal activities and protecting the security of the account and personal information;
- xii. Allow you to participate in surveys and other forms of market research, sweepstakes, contests and similar promotions and to administer these activities. Some of these activities have additional rules, which may contain additional information about how personal information is used and shared;
- xiii. Business purposes, including data analysis, audits, developing and improving products and services, enhancing the Site, identifying usage trends and determining the effectiveness of promotional campaigns;
- xiv. For risk control, for fraud detection and prevention, to comply with laws and regulations, and to comply with other legal process and law enforcement requirements;
- xv. Allow you to utilize features within our Sites by granting us access to information from your device such as contact lists, or geo-location when you request certain services;
- xvi. We shall use personal information to provide customer services and products;
- xvii. Based on the request of Governmental compliance bodies, our regulators, and judicial bodies, we may disclose personal information;
- xviii. We may also use personal information to advertise our products and offerings to you;
- xix. We will also use your information to detect abnormalities or fraudulent activities on our system;
- xx. We only store data for the purpose which it was collected. The retention period for storage of data is also largely determined by Legal and Regulatory bodies;
- xxi. Finally, we may contact you as necessary to enforce our policies, applicable law, or any agreement we may have with you.

4. Security of Data

We protect your information using physical, technical, and administrative security measures to reduce the risks of loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, and alteration.

We run a secure security architecture from applications, software, and processes to secure data from outsiders and abuse from insiders.

We use advanced tools to secure data at rest and data in transit.

We comply with a management system for business continuity, quality management, information security, and payment cards.

Only a few employees based on role-based access are permitted by us to have access to personal information.

Some of the safeguards we use are firewalls and data encryption, physical access controls to our data centers, and information access authorization controls. We have also taken additional measures by ensuring our system complies with industry information security standards.

5. Changes to your Details

Keeping your account information accurate and up to date is very important. If your account information is incomplete, inaccurate or not current, please use the Contact option on our Site, or call or write to us at telephone numbers or appropriate address for changes listed on your account statements, records, online or other account materials. You can also speak to a customer representative from the Company.

6. Customer Rights

- The right to request your personal information.
- The right to access your data held by us.
- The right to restrict the processing of your personal information.
- The right to rectify your personal information.
- The right to erase personal information if there is no Legal or Regulatory requirement that this is held.

7. Information Automatically Collected from your Computer

We and our third-party service providers may collect and use other information in a variety of ways, including:

- **Log files/IP addresses:** When you visit the Site our web server automatically records your IP address. This IP address is not linked to any of your personal information. We use IP addresses to help us administer the Site and to collect demographic information for aggregation purposes.
- **Other technologies including pixel tags, web beacons, and clear GIFs:** These may be used in connection with some Site pages, downloadable mobile applications and HTML-formatted email messages to measure the effectiveness of our communications, the success of our marketing campaigns, to compile statistics about usage and response rates, to personalize/tailor your experience while engaging with us online and offline, for fraud detection and prevention, for security purposes, for advertising, and to assist us in resolving account holders' questions regarding use of our Site.

- **Aggregated and De-identified Data:** Aggregated and De-identified Data is data that we may create or compile from various sources, including but not limited to accounts and transactions. This information, which does not identify individual account holders, may be used for our business purposes, which may include offering products or services, research, marketing or analysing market trends, and other purposes consistent with applicable laws.
- **Through your browser or device:** Certain information is collected by most browsers and/or through your device, such as your Media Access Control (MAC) address, device type, screen resolution, operating system version and internet browser type and version. We use this information to ensure Sites function properly, for fraud detection and prevention, and security purposes.
- We may also gather other non-personal information (from which we cannot identify you) such as the type of your internet browser, which we use to provide you with a more effective service.

8. Cookies

When you visit the Site we may store some information (commonly known as a “cookie”) on your computer. Cookies are small files of information that use a unique identification tag and are stored on your device as a result of using the Site or other services we provide to you. Several cookies we use last only for the duration of your session and expire when you close your browser. Other cookies are used to remember you when you return to the site and will last for longer. A cookie helps you get the best out of the Site and helps us to provide you with a more customized and tailored service. We use cookies to:

- i. Save you having to re-enter your details each time you visit the Site;
- ii. Track how our Site is used and to improve and update our content;
- iii. Store your preferences;
- iv. Customize elements of the layout and/or content of the site for you;
- v. Collect statistical information about how you use the site so that we can improve the site.

You can refuse to accept these cookies and most devices and browsers offer their privacy settings for cookies. You will need to manage your cookie settings for each device and browser you use. However, if you do not accept these cookies, you may experience some inconvenience in your use of the Site and some online products and services. For example, we will not be able to recognize your device and you will need to answer a challenge question each time you log on. You also may not receive tailored advertising or other offers from us that may be relevant to your interests and needs.

9. Security

To protect personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with applicable federal laws. These measures may include device safeguards and secured files and buildings as well as oversight of our third-party service providers to ensure information remains confidential and secure.

We have implemented technology and policies to safeguard your privacy from unauthorized access and improper use. We use secure server software (SSL) to encrypt any financial information you need to input before it is sent to us.

10. Linking to Third Party Websites and Other Aggregation Websites

Linking to other sites: We may provide links to third party sites, which may include service providers or merchants. If you follow links to sites not affiliated or controlled by us, you should review their privacy and security policies and other terms and conditions, as they may be different from those of our Sites. We do not guarantee and are not responsible for the privacy or security of these sites, including the accuracy, completeness, or reliability of their information.

We cannot be responsible for the privacy policies and practices of other sites even if you access them using links from our Site and recommend that you check the policy of each site you visit and contact its owner or operator if you have any concerns or questions.

If you provide your Site username, password or other information about your accounts with us to an aggregation website, we will consider that you have authorized all transactions or actions initiated by an aggregation website using access information you provide, whether or not you were aware of a specific transaction or action. If you decide to revoke the authority you have given to an aggregation website, we strongly recommend that you change your password for the Site to ensure that the aggregation website cannot continue to access your account.

11. Social Media Sites
